



Host Our Exhibitions

Our exhibitions offer unique glimpses of the often underrecognized creative talents of people with disabilities. Hosting an AFA exhibition starts at \$50 per week with a suggested minimum of six weeks, though we strive to accommodate your budget. Our exhibitions staff will work with you to design an outstanding exhibit.

What You'll Get

Art

Your choice of award-winning, framed two and three-dimensional art by Wisconsin artists with disabilities. These objects of beauty and value are imbued with powerful meaning and reflect the distinctive journey of professional and emerging artists.

Signage

A sign introducing the exhibition, accompanied by artwork labels that include the artists' names, hometowns, artwork titles, and brief statements about the art.

Support

Our staff will promote the exhibit in your space via social media posts and in our e-newsletter.

Artist Talk (optional)

An artist can visit your venue to share their experience of living with a disability and being an artist. There is an additional fee for an artist talk.

What You Need

Accessible, Free, Public Exhibit Space

We require the space containing AFA's collections be accessible to all and fully ADA-compliant. If your facility has an admission fee, the AFA collection must be displayed in a public area that is free and open to the public. For more information about exhibition accessibility, please contact us.

Space to Display All Works of Art

There may be 3-D pieces that require display options beyond wall space, such as a pedestal. You can find information about the artwork on our website, including the dimensions of each piece.

Commitment to Exhibit

We prefer an engagement of at least six weeks. In occasional instances, a four-week display period is accepted.

Ability To Install The Artwork

We will bring the art to you in crates (which you may store at your facility). We will pick up the exhibit when the exhibition has ended, but we ask that you unpack, hang, and re-pack the art as it was brought to you. Installation includes placement of labels and signs. In some instances, we can assist with installation.
