We know that the 2022-23 year will see choir participation continue to expand beyond the long time choirs in **Appleton**, **Madison**, **Milwaukee**, and **Wisconsin Rapids**.

CULTURAL PROGRAMMING FOR PEOPLE WITH MEMORY LOSS

A part of the SPARK! Alliance, our new program for people with early to mid-stage Alzheimer's and dementia and their care partners was made possible by a two-year grant from **Bader Philanthropies**. Additional funding for the first year came from the **Green Bay Packers Foundation**, the **Evjue Foundation**, and corporate partner **Numbers4Nonprofits**. SPARK! programs are entirely free and keep participants actively engaged in their communities by providing experiences that stimulate conversations, provide peer support, and inspire creativity through engaging workshops. "We've all been feeling stifled. That's why I find this so stimulating," one particpating Care Partner told us. "I mean this in the best way possible: it's adult kindergarten. We can use imagination, and no one will judge you."

Arts Education

Our Arts Education programming continues to blossom following the restrictions of the pandemic and the restructuring of how programs are organized and implemented. Included under Director of Arts Education's Jill Jaworski's umbrella are School & Community Arts, SPARK!, Vets Arts Studios, Arts Classes in Madison, and Choirs.

Our Off-Site Youth Education is also rebounding, and in fiscal year 2022 we could be found at Wauwatosa West High School, Blue Lotus Farms and Retreat, Lincoln Elementary School, Goodman Community Center, and GiGi's Playhouse-Madison, among other sites.

In its first year the **Wispact Foundation** distributed funds to 22 non-profit organizations, and we were proud to receive support for our Arts Education programming. Funding also came from the **American Girl Fund for Children**, the **Steve Stricker American Family Insurance Foundation**, and the **Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction**.

IN ARTS EDUCATION PROGRAMS

Art Center Transformation

Thanks to the generous support of the **Tikkun Olam Madison Fund**, with a large gift that generated many more donations, we raised \$30,000 to transform our Art Center in Madison. The first phase of the transformation included upgrading and replacing furniture to create an even more accessible and flexible space. The improvements that were made possible by our donors, such as **Amcor Cares, TASC**, **Sub-Zero Wolf Foundation**, the **Nelson Family Charitable Fund**, and **Demco** included providing new sitting areas for our main gallery and entry area, replacing outdated and inaccessible storage with easily movable and viewable storage cabinets, upgrading our art tables to be more user-friendly and portable, installing new magnetic white boards in our art class area, and turning our former gift shop into a welcome center and office for Program Associate **Matthew Sanborn**.

We also began Phase Two of the project by creating the **Phil Porter Memorial Gallery**, generously funded by the **Porter Family, Leslie and Dave Griffith,** and **Jim and Sharon Riordan**. The transformation will continue this year with the replacement of our old exterior sign with **newly branded signs** on the north and east sides of the building.

In fiscal year 2022 we returned to in-person sales at **Madison Museum of Contemporary Art's Art Fair on the Square** for the thirty-second year (almost in a row)! We also were at the **Middleton Art Walk**, **Schuster's Farm** in Deerfield, and the **Festival of Spring at the Paine Art Center** in Oshkosh. AFA artists exhibited at **Arts + Literature Laboratory**, **Overture Center for the Arts**, **Madison Children's Museum**, **MYArts**, among other venues. The artwork of veterans was highlighted at a corporate exhibit called **Veterans Branch Out** for **Generac** in Waukesha, and we added a collection through our Cattle Call (for Art).

The CREATIVE POWER Traveling Exhibition was generously funded this year by Engaged Neighbors.




